## Download and install Microsoft

#### **Teams**

Download and install Microsoft Teams for Desktop

Download and install Microsoft Teams for *Desktop* from <u>here</u>.

- You may not have access to all the features if you are not using the desktop version of Microsoft Teams
- Please check the <u>System Requirements for Microsoft</u>
  Teams.

We strongly encourage you to use the desktop application of Microsoft Teams instead of the web browser version. You can find the feature differences in Table 1.




## SpeD 2021 – Virtual Event

You may connect to Conference sessions (and also to other channels sessions) by clicking the *Join* button.






### **Device setup**

#### Configure your device for joining a session

- It is strongly recommended to use a video camera and an external microphone for your presentation.
- Before joining a session you can turn on/off the camera and add a virtual background.
- If you are using external devices (camera/mic), please check your external devices setup.
- Please, set your microphone on mute before joining.





#### Session – Audience

- Please enjoy the presentations and don't interrupt the speakers.
- Please use the *Chat* or *Raise Hand* functions for asking questions and wait to be invited to speak by the chairman.
- Make sure you *Unmute* your microphone only after you are nominated by the chairman.





## **Presenting**

#### **Session – Presenter**

- Once you have been invited to present by the chairman, you must share your presentation with the others using *Share content*.
- Don't forget to *Unmute* your microphone before you begin your presentation.
- Your video feed will be put on *Spotlight* (all the other participant will see your camera regarding on who's talking).






## **Presenting**

#### **Sharing content**

You have 2 basic options for sharing content:

- 1. **Desktop** you will share your screen and everybody will see your desktop (not recommended)
- 2. *Window* you will share a specific window (presentation must be open)

If you wish to share sound from your computer, click on *Include computer sound* button.





## **Presenting**Sharing a window

Sharing a *Window* is the best way for sharing content because you can share your presentation regardless of its format (.ppt, .pptx, .pdf or other).

- If you have an older version of Office, it is possible that the other participants will not see your presentation correctly you will need to share the PowerPoint Slide Show, not the .ppt file.
- The shared window will have a red outline. You will have control over your presentation as long as you stay active in this red outline.
- You can stop presenting / sharing by pressing the **Stop presentation** on the top (active when your cursor is on the top of the screen) or **Stop sharing on** the bottom.
